General Event Information:

Tech: There will not be any tech on Friday night: tech will be handled on Saturday morning and Sunday morning. If your region is a Great Lakes Region and has annual tech provisions we will honor those tech agreements and not require additional Detroit Region tech.

On site parking: There will be plenty of parking available onsite.

Overnight Parking: You can leave your race car / trailer on the site Saturday night but it will be at your own risk.

Food Vendor: There will be no food vendor on site during the event. There are a couple of fast food restaurants just down the street as well as some service stations.

Points: This event will count as two separate points events for the Detroit Region & for the Great Lakes Solo Series. Results will be separate for Saturday and then for Sunday. Times will not be combined from the two days.

Sound: In the interest of retaining our sites, sound levels of each car will be monitored and enforced based on the Detroit Region Supplemental.

Measured sound not to exceed 100db from a distance of 50'. If any car is measured over the sound limit a warning will be issued after the first run, if after the second run the car is still over the participant will be required to stop running.

SOLO SERIES Decais: All vehicles entered in the event must have a Solo Series sticker on each of their sides in the upright position. These are available for purchase at a cost of \$3.00 per pair.

Trophies: Will be awarded based on the COMBINED TIMES from BOTH days of competition to those eligible.
