

Great American Solo Series Charter

23 October 2006

The Great American Solo Series (GASS), herein referred to as “Series”, was created to:

- Promote great events within the Central and Great Lakes Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) Divisions.
- Increase competition within the SCCA Divisions.
- Help to improve individual driving skills that will help Solo drivers win more trophies at the SCCA Solo National Championships.
- Create new friendships within the SCCA Divisions.
- Unify the Solo Community.
- Promote SCCA.

With these goals, the following structure shall be executed by the Great American Solo Series:

1. Official Series Rules shall be maintained and published.
2. The Series shall be a collection of Regional/Club-level Solo events.
3. The Series shall be governed by a voluntary Committee, which shall operate as a benevolent dictatorship, under the auspices of the Chairperson or Co-Chairs, and shall be made up of the following positions:
 - Chairperson (1 or 2),
 - Treasurer,
 - Bulletin Editor,
 - Mailing List Keeper,
 - Regional Liaison (1 or 2),
 - Historian,
 - Banquet Chairperson,
 - Trophy Chairperson,
 - Sponsor Liaison,
 - Pointskeeper,
 - Media Relations,
 - Schedule Listings,
 - Advertising,
 - Member-At-Large,
 - Website Contact.
4. An Official Series Bulletin shall be published periodically during the competition season, distributed to active Soloists, and shall provide:
 - Series Rules,
 - Information on Solo and related events,
 - Series and other Solo event schedule,
 - Point of contact list for Central and Great Lakes Divisions Solo events,
 - Results of Series events,
 - Individual entrant points standings for Series events,
 - Series event flyers and entry forms,
 - Personal and Commercial advertising.
5. A Year-end Series Meeting and Awards Banquet shall be held at the conclusion of each competition year.
